

FEDERAL / STATE GRANTS

Recreation and Conservation Office: Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF)

Purpose: Funds for acquisition, development, and/or renovation for projects that provides lands and facilities desirable for individual active participation, and projects which provide active connections between communities and recreation sites and facilities.

Deadline: Begin application as soon as possible. Application process simply involves providing your organization's name, name of project, and the grant program in which you are applying. Completed Applications are due by May 3, 2010. [APPLICATIONS](#)

Recreation and Conservation Office: Washington Wildlife Recreation Program (WWRP)

Purpose: Provides funding for a broad range of land protection and outdoor recreation, including park acquisition and development, habitat conservation, farmland preservation, and construction of outdoor recreation facilities.

Deadline: Begin application as soon as possible. Application process simply involves providing your organization's name, name of project, and the grant program in which you are applying. Completed Applications are due by May 3, 2010. [APPLICATIONS](#)

Purpose: provide low-interest loans for projects that address the needs of eligible local governments for the following systems: bridges, roads, streets, domestic water, sanitary sewer, storm water, solid waste, and recycling systems. Because Yakima County is considered "distressed," no local match is required.

Deadline: May 11, 2010

Community Development Block Grants – Planning-Only Grants

Purpose: Support eligible small communities and rural counties in Washington State in attaining the planning tools necessary to implement priority projects that principally benefit low- and moderate-income (LMI) persons.

Deadline: Available between March 1 and October 31, 2010 until all funds awarded

Federal Highways Bridge Program

Purpose: Funding for local agency bridges that are classified as structurally deficient with a sufficiency rating of 50 or less based on the bridge data when submitted. Program administered by the Washington State Department of Transportation..

Deadline: April 30, 2010

U.S. Department of Energy 2010 Weatherization Assistance Program for Low-Income Persons

Purpose: Fund projects that increase the energy efficiency of dwellings owned or occupied by low-income persons, reduce their total residential expenditures, and improve their health and safety.

Deadline: February 15, May 1, August 1, 2010

Washington State Department of Transportation Safe Routes to School Program

Purpose: To increase the number of children walking and biking to school safely. Eligible projects may include three elements: 1) Engineering improvements, 2) education and encouragement activities, and 3) enforcement efforts.

Deadline: May 3, 2010

Economic Development Assistance Programs - Public Works

Purpose: Support the construction or rehabilitation of essential public infrastructure and facilities.

Deadline: September 30, 2010

Economic Development Assistance Programs - Planning

Purpose: Support planning organizations in the development, implementation, revision or replacement of comprehensive economic development strategies, and for related short-term planning investments and State plans designed to create and retain higher-skill, higher-wage jobs, particularly for the unemployed and underemployed in the nation's most economically distressed regions.

Deadline: September 30, 2010

Economic Development Assistance Programs - Local Technical Assistance

Purpose: Fill the knowledge and information gaps that may prevent leaders in the public and nonprofit sectors in economically distressed regions from making optimal decisions on local economic development issues.

Deadline: September 30, 2010

Economic Development Assistance Programs - Economic Adjustment Assistance

Purpose: Technical, planning and infrastructure assistance in regions experiencing adverse economic changes that may occur suddenly or over time.

Deadline: September 30, 2010

USDA-RD Community Facilities Grants

Purpose: Assist in the development of essential community facilities in rural areas and towns of up to 20,000 in population. Small and low-income communities receive higher priority.

Deadline: Applications may be made at any time.

USDA-RD Water and Wastewater Disposal Loan and Grant Program

Purpose: Construct, enlarge, and improve rural water, sanitary sewage, solid waste disposal, and wastewater disposal facilities. Grants supplement direct loans made by the program. Percentage loan based on community's median household income.

Deadline: Applications may be made at any time.

NONPROFIT

National Trust Preservation Funds

Purpose: Preservation planning and educational efforts; intervention funds for preservation emergencies.

Deadline: June 1, 2010
