

## **FEDERAL / STATE GRANTS**

### **Community Planning Challenge Grant & DOT TIGER II**

Purpose: Foster reform and reduce barriers to achieving affordable, economically vital, and sustainable communities. Such efforts may include amending or replacing local master plans, zoning codes, and building codes to promote mixed-use development, affordable housing, the reuse of older buildings and structures for new purposes, and similar activities with the goal of promoting sustainability at the local or neighborhood level.

Deadline: Pre-application July 26, 2010. Full application August 23, 2010.

### **Transportation Improvement Board**

Purpose: Provide transportation infrastructure to cities with populations of less than 5,000 through Small City Arterial Program, Small City Preservation Program, and Small City Sidewalk Program, and to cities with populations of more than 5,000 through Urban Arterial Program.

Deadline: Applications postmarked August 31, 2010.

### **Community Development Block Grants – Planning-Only Grants**

Purpose: Support eligible small communities and rural counties in Washington State in attaining the planning tools necessary to implement priority projects that principally benefit low- and moderate-income (LMI) persons.

Deadline: Available between March 1 and October 31, 2010 until all funds awarded

### **U.S. Department of Energy 2010 Weatherization Assistance Program for Low-Income Persons**

Purpose: Fund projects that increase the energy efficiency of dwellings owned or occupied by low-income persons, reduce their total residential expenditures, and improve their health and safety.

Deadline: February 15, May 1, August 1, 2010

### **Economic Development Assistance Programs - Public Works**

Purpose: Support the construction or rehabilitation of essential public infrastructure and facilities.

Deadline: September 30, 2010

### **Economic Development Assistance Programs - Planning**

Purpose: Support planning organizations in the development, implementation, revision or replacement of comprehensive economic development strategies, and for related short-term planning investments and State plans designed to create and retain higher-skill, higher-wage jobs, particularly for the unemployed and underemployed in the nation's most economically distressed regions.

Deadline: September 30, 2010

### **Economic Development Assistance Programs - Local Technical Assistance**

Purpose: Fill the knowledge and information gaps that may prevent leaders in the public and nonprofit sectors in economically distressed regions from making optimal decisions on local economic development issues.

Deadline: September 30, 2010

### **Economic Development Assistance Programs - Economic Adjustment Assistance**

Purpose: Technical, planning and infrastructure assistance in regions experiencing adverse economic changes that may occur suddenly or over time.

Deadline: September 30, 2010

### **USDA-RD Community Facilities Grants**

Purpose: Assist in the development of essential community facilities in rural areas and towns of up to 20,000 in population. Small and low-income communities receive higher priority.

Deadline: Applications may be made at any time.

### **USDA-RD Water and Wastewater Disposal Loan and Grant Program**

Purpose: Construct, enlarge, and improve rural water, sanitary sewage, solid waste disposal, and wastewater disposal facilities. Grants supplement direct loans made by the program. Percentage loan based on community's median household income.

Deadline: Applications may be made at any time.

### **Washington Traffic Safety Commission Mini-grants**

Purpose: Funds projects addressing implementation of traffic safety strategies, public education campaigns, equipment or materials, and training or travel.

Deadline: Applications accepted at any time.

## **NONPROFIT**

### **Bikes Belong Grant Program**

Purpose: Fund bicycle facilities, including including bike paths, trails, and bridges; mountain bike facilities, bike parks, and BMX facilities; and advocacy programs, including programs that transform city streets, innovative pilot projects, and initiatives that have a significant political impact.

Deadline: August 27, 2010, early November 2010

### **National Trust Preservation Funds**

Purpose: Preservation planning and educational efforts; intervention funds for preservation emergencies.

Deadline: June 1, 2010
