

2. In nonattainment and maintenance areas, sections 174 and 176 (c) and (d) of the Clean Air Act, as amended (42 U.S.C. 7504, 7506 (c) and (d)) and 40 CFR part 93;
3. Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended (42 U.S.C. 2000d-1) and 49 CFR part 21;
4. 49 U.S.C. 5332, prohibiting discrimination on the basis of race, color, creed, national origin, sex, or age in employment or business opportunity;
5. Section 1101(b) of the SAFETEA-LU (Pub. L. 109-59) and 49 CFR part 26 regarding the involvement of disadvantaged business enterprises in USDOT funded projects;
6. 23 CFR part 230, regarding the implementation of an equal employment opportunity program on Federal and Federal-aid highway construction contracts;
7. The provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12101 *et seq.*) and 49 CFR parts 27, 37, 38, and 28 CFR Part 35;
8. The Older Americans Act, as amended (42 U.S.C. 6101), prohibiting discrimination on the basis of age in programs or activities receiving Federal financial assistance;
9. Section 324 of title 23 U.S.C. regarding the prohibition of discrimination based on gender; and
10. Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. 794) and 49 CFR part 27 regarding discrimination against individuals with disabilities.

FINDINGS

TIME FRAME:

The Yakima Valley Conference of Governments' (YVCOG) Metropolitan and Regional Transportation Improvement Program (M/RTIP) amendment for September 2009 includes years 2009 through 2012.

PROJECTS INCLUDED:

Eight projects are included in the September 2009 formal amendment into the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). Seven funding secured projects are corrected into the STIP and 97 planned projects (listed in the STIP Reports section) are amended into the Yakima Valley MTIP. These planned projects may then be corrected into the STIP once project funding becomes secured.

City of Union Gap

Valley Mall Boulevard Reconstruction – Phase IV

Action – Add new project to the STIP. Project Cost: \$3,910,000 in state funds for a total project cost of \$3,910,000.

Union Gap School Crossing Improvements

Action – Add new project to the STIP. Project Cost: \$227,000 in state funds for a total project cost of \$227,000.

School Safety Projects

Action – Add new project to the STIP. Project Cost: \$8,000,000 in state funds for a total project cost of \$8,000,000.

City of Yakima

Yakima Railroad Grade Separations – Phase 2

Action – Change federal fund code to a project currently included in the STIP. Project Cost: \$10,938,000 in federal funds, \$5,200,000 in state funds and \$2,000,000 in local funds for a total project cost of \$18,138,000.

66th Ave. & Summitview Intersection

Action – Add new project to the STIP. Project Cost: \$600,000 in local funds for a total project cost of \$600,000.

Yakima Transit

Acquisition of new Dial-A-Ride paratransit vehicles

Action – Add federal funds and adjust project costs to a project currently included in the STIP. Project Cost: \$96,000 in federal funds and \$84,000 in state funds for a total project cost of \$180,000.

Fixed Route Bus Service to Moxee Along SR 24 Corridor

Action – Add new project to the STIP. Project Cost: \$131,000 in federal funds and \$131,000 in local funds for a total project cost of \$262,000.

Washington State Department of Transportation – South Central Region

Acquisition of new Dial-A-Ride paratransit vehicles

Action – Add new project to the STIP. Project Cost: \$609,000 in federal funds and \$16,000 in local funds for a total project cost of \$625,000.

PRIORITY OF PROJECTS:

The projects in the TIP were selected and prioritized using a process that considered transportation planning, safety, preservation, and increased efficiency of the transportation system. YVCOG supports all aspects of the transportation system including air, roads, public transportation, sidewalks, bike lanes, and travel demand management.

The projects included in the Yakima Valley September M/RTIP amendment were selected and prioritized in accordance with YVCOG's regionally established transportation goals and policies.

FINANCIAL PLAN:

The financial plan, beginning on page five of the 2009-2012 M/RTIP, indicates the TIP can be financially implemented and the funds programmed do not exceed estimated revenues. This M/RTIP amendment uses federal, state and local funds.

The Strategic Planning and Programming Division, the Highways and Local Programs Division, and the Public Transportation and Commute Options Division reviewed this M/RTIP amendment for September 2009 and, based on expected revenue, it is financially constrained.

COOPERATION:

The YVCOG developed the September 2009 major amendment to the Yakima Valley M/RTIP in cooperation with the City of Selah, City of Yakima, City of Union Gap, Yakima Transit and the Washington State Department of Transportation – South Central Region.

PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT:

The YVCOG public involvement process is described on page four of the 2009-2012 M/RTIP. The public review period for the September M/RTIP amendment was held from September 4, 2009 through September 18, 2009. Public notices announcing the review period for the September M/RTIP amendment were published in one local paper of record -- the *Yakima Herald-Republic* on September 4, 2009 and September 14, 2009. A draft copy of the amendment was made available for public viewing at several physical sites as well as on the YVCOG website at www.yvco.org.

CONGESTION MANAGEMENT PROCESS:

The YVCOG is not a Transportation Management Area (TMA) and is not required to have a Congestion Management Process (CMP).

AIR QUALITY CONFORMITY:

The Yakima Valley has a limited maintenance plan for both CO and PM₁₀. All projects in the 2009-2012 TIP demonstrated that CO and PM₁₀ levels do not exceed thresholds established for conformity and for attaining and maintaining healthful air quality standards.

This September 2009 major amendment to the Yakima Valley M/RTIP does not negatively impact air quality and was found to be in conformance with federal air quality standards. Two of the projects included in the September 2009 major amendment were modeled for air quality conformity purposes and it was found that CO and PM₁₀ levels do not exceed established thresholds. The conformity determination for the 2009-2012 M/RTIP can be found in Appendix E of the 2009-2012 M/RTIP.

METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN CONSISTENCY:

The projects included in the September amendment are consistent with the goals and policies of the *Yakima Valley Metropolitan and Regional Transportation Plan 2007-2027* and local comprehensive plans.

INTERMODAL/MULTIMODAL APPROACH:

Projects in Yakima Valley's M/RTIP provide for the development of an integrated transportation network that focuses on the safe and efficient movement of people and goods. The Yakima Valley M/RTIP includes street, bicycle, pedestrian, rail, safety, bridge, highway, and transit related projects.

FUNDING FLEXIBILITY:

The funding flexibility provisions of SAFETEA-LU were not used in the development of the YVCOG's 2009-2012 M/RTIP. The various categories of funding were used for their intended purpose.

CROSS-REGIONAL CONSISTENCY:

There are no adjacent MPOs. Cross-regional consistency of the TIP is achieved by active participation among the WSDOT South Central Region, Benton-Franklin Council of Governments, the QUADCO Regional Transportation Planning Organization, and the Southwest Washington Regional Transportation Council.

CONCLUSION

After review and analysis of the Yakima Valley Conference of Governments' M/RTIP major amendment for September 2009, and as set forth in the above findings, the Policy Development and Regional Coordination Branch find the amendment in compliance with the requirements of Sec. 134, Title 23 U.S.C.

RECOMMENDATION

Based on the above findings and conclusion, the Policy Development and Regional Coordination Branch recommend the Secretary of Transportation approve the September 2009 M/RTIP major amendment for the Yakima Valley Conference of Governments.
