WELCOMING REMARKS

Mayor Roger Wentz, welcomed everyone to the City of Union Gap.

BUSINESS

Approval of Minutes

Mr. Hodkinson entertained a motion to approve the Minutes of the January 21, 2015 General Membership Meeting. Mr. Wentz, Union Gap, moved to approve the Minutes and Mr. Elliott, Yakima County, seconded the motion. The motion carried.

YVCOG NEWS & ANNOUNCEMENTS

Larry Mattson, YVCOG Executive Director, stated that he is happy to have recently spent some time in the cities of Granger, Zillah, Toppenish, and Naches, attending various meetings, and he expects to be doing so in our remaining jurisdictions in the near future.

Mr. Mattson provided a brief update on what has been happening with bringing Homeless Network to YVCOG. An interlocal agreement and budget amendment will be brought before the Executive Committee at the April meeting, and before the General Membership at the May 20th meeting.

Shawn Conrad, YVCOG Senior Planner, mentioned the Funder's Forum held March 13, 2015 and asked for feedback from those who were in attendance, and also inquired as to whether there is interest in having another one next year. She asked members to contact her with comments.

PROGRAM

Yakima County's recently elected Sheriff, Brian Winter, and Prosecuting Attorney, Joseph (Joe) Brusic, each shared some of their personal and professional background and qualifications for their positions. They also shared their visions, goals, and perspectives of their departments and stated their mutual desire for multiple Yakima County law enforcement agencies to work together, giving some examples of how they have recently been able to do so.

Sherriff Winter gave some background on the 3/10 Sales Tax proposition. This money goes directly to law and justice – not into the General Fund. This will be a county-wide vote, and will impact the entire county. Commissioner Rand Elliott, and Union Gap City Manager, Rod Otterness, also spoke out in support of the 3/10 Sales Tax bill. This money is essential in order to maintain Yakima County's current law and justice departments' status quo.

Prosecuting Attorney Brusic commented on his support of the 3/10 Sales Tax.
