APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Ms. Gonzales moved to approve the October 16, 2017 minutes. Mr. Leita seconded the motion. The motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

WSDOT Human Services Transportation Plan (HSTP) Implementation Agreement

Mr. Mattson gave information about the HSTP Implementation agreement. Mr. Hodkinson considered a motion that the Policy Board approve and give authorization for the chairman to sign the WSDOT/HSTP Agreement. Ms. Carlson moved, and Mr. Leita seconded the motion. Motion carries.

YVCOG 2018 CMAQ Program Local Agency Agreement

Mr. Mattson gave information on the 2018 Congestion Mitigation Air Quality Local Agency Agreement. Mr. Hodkinson considered a motion that the Policy Board approve and authorize for the chairman to sign the WSDOT/YVCOG (CMAQ) LAA. Mr. Leita moved, and Ms. Gonzales seconded the motion. Yakima Valley Regional ITS Architecture Annual Update

Mr. Adolf gave information on the annual update of the Yakima Valley Regional Intelligent Transportation Systems Plan. The Technical Advisory Committee recommends approval that included minor edits and text revisions that correspond with the 2017-2040 Yakima Valley Metropolitan and Regional Transit Plan. Mr. Hodkinson considered a motion to approve the ITS Plan Annual Update. Ms. Adkison moved, and Ms. Gonzales seconded the motion. Motion carries.

(CTR) Administrative Work Plan

YVCOG Commute Trip Reduction Mr. Adolf gave an update of the Commute Trip Reduction program and YVCOG's new coordinator is Brian Galloway. WSDOT has approved the work plan that will be YVCOG's activity blueprint for the next two years. YVCOG has successfully updated contacts with existing CTR affected business and will

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begin a voluntary effort with non-CRP affected businesses promoting the use of car pools, van pools, bike racks, and enhancing transit options. \$148,600 was received to fund CTR program through June 2019.

Human Services Transportation Plan (HSTP) Update Kickoff Mr. Adolf and Mr. Shuttleworth provided information on the HSTP update process and how YVCOG and the Coordinated Grant Program will use the data gathered on the Coordinated Transit services in Yakima County.

Mr. Shuttleworth will be the lead for this project. Outreach includes talking with as many service providers and users as possible. The elected are key in getting the word out. New this year is an online survey component. We will have flyers, postcards and other announcements on websites and electronic distribution. YVCOG is available to work with cities to post this information and links to the survey.

CTR Strategic Plan Update

Mr. Mattson provided information on the Commute Trip Reduction Strategic Plan Update. Mr. Mattson was appointed to the State board and has been serving since June. The CTR Board has been exploring 3 options. One is local flexibility to explore alternative programs instead of traditional CTR. Second path is to explore traffic demand management outside of CTR, and the 3rd is an educational component to increase awareness of options other than driving alone.

Key Due Dates	Key Action Due
On or before December 31, 2016	WSDOT Tribal and Regional Coordination Office (TRCO) provides estimated planning funding allocations to MPOs and RTPOs for SFY 2018.
February 2017	WSDOT TRCO schedules UPWP coordination meetings among WSDOT, FHWA, FTA, and the MPOs/RTPOs (as applicable).
March 20, 2017	MPOs send draft UPWPs electronically to the WSDOT TRCO, FHWA and FTA. RTPOs send draft UPWPs electronically to the WSDOT TRCO. Exceptions: RTC: UPWP Due Date – February 8, 2017 LCVMPO: UPWP Due Date – August 15, 2017
April – June 2017	WSDOT TRCO, Public Transportation Division, WSDOT Region Planners, FHWA, and FTA representatives meet with MPOs to discuss the draft UPWPs. Note: WSDOT will meet separately with RTPOs not affiliated with MPOs during this same time period.
May - June 2017	MPOs and RTPOs take final UPWPs to Policy Boards for adoption.
June 16, 2017	MPOs and RTPOs submit the adopted UPWP electronically to the WSDOT TRCO.
June 21, 2017	WSDOT TRCO submits MPO adopted UPWPs electronically to FHWA/FTA
June 30, 2017	FHWA/FTA UPWP issue formal approval
July 1, 2017	Approved SFY 2018 UPWP work begins
