CTR Strategic Plan

On June 22, the CTR (State) Board adopted a draft Strategic Plan to add more flexibility to the program. WSDOT is now making minor formatting changes to the Plan and the final version will soon be published. At the same time, WSDOT is producing more current, useful data about how people commute and their transportation choices.

Jurisdictional Plan Updates

Good news! The CTR (State) Board has decided to exempt jurisdictions from updating their CTR Plans during the 2019-2023 cycle. The reason: the CTR Board recently updated its CTR Strategic Plan but is still working out the details about how to implement it.
