Kathy Geil, Local Crime Lab Program Manager provided an update on Local Crime Lab recent happenings, and Byron Gumz updated the General Membership on current Planning Program activities.

	Chairman Restucci introduced Mr. Hester to the General Membership. Mr. Hester has served as the Executive Director for the Port of Sunnyside since 2013, after having previously served as the Port's Property Development and Project Manager since 2007.		
	He provided the General Membership with an interesting overview of what a port district is and provided examples of some of their many accomplishments. The mission of the port is 'To develop, broaden and strengthen an economic base throughout the District in an environmentally prudent manner."		
	The Port of Sunnyside has been in existence since 1964 and consists of about 300,000 acres. The first property they acquired within the city was in 2016 – previously focused on building business parks outside the city limits.
