CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS

TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM CORRESPONDENCE AND UPDATES

Alan Adolf, Transportation Planning Manager

Mr. Adolf provided a debriefing on the Central Washington State Fair booth taxpayer activity results and the transportation survey. Pretty decent turn out – averaged about 60 people per day. Maintenance and preservation of the road and bridge system took number 1 and passenger rail took number 2. Transit finished 3rd. Youth were interested in road maintenance, bike/ped, drone technology, aviation, and environmental/wildlife. Will be doing this again at the Veteran's Stand Down, a Harmon Center wellness fair, and a tribal event in White Swan. Results will be included in the Long-Range Plan.

About 110 transportation surveys were completed during the fair. Still receiving electronic surveys.

Mr. Adolf gave a brief overview of the East Valley-Moxee to Yakima Corridors Study, which has been completed.

The WSDOT Active Transportation Program Design Guide is available. Taking public comment through December 10th.

Mr. Adolf introduced Ben Griffard from Street Simplified Software, who provided a brief presentation on their traffic safety analytics software. AI analyzation and generation. There is an opportunity here for jurisdictional use should we be awarded the Safety Action Plan grant.

CTR Program Update

The metropolitan jurisdictions and the county will need to update their plans and potentially their code. May schedule a meeting to discuss WSDOT guidance and how to move forward. Must be done in 2 years – YVCOG will be spearheading that task.

FY 2024-2027 MPO/RTPO M/RTIP

The final document has been put together – we have received a couple of comments, including one received from WSDOT yesterday. There will probably be a few more changes, but the document is ready for recommendation to the Policy Board for approval.

Decision: Rocky Wallace moved for TAC recommendation that Policy Board approve the 2024-2027 M/RTIP document for submittal to WSDOT/FHWA. Jeff Ranger seconded the motion. The motion carried.

STBG / TA / CMAQ / CRP: Forecast and Redistribution Update

Still a work in progress – don't know yet how much to expect for 2024 allocation. Randy Giles anticipates we will stay close to the \$3.8 million, and we do anticipate a de-obligation of approximately \$250,000 from the Mabton project, and maybe some from Selah. Our STBG target will probably be a little over \$4 million.

Due to ongoing DOT and federal requirements, Naches's trail access project, including the demolition of the old railroad warehouse, is short on funding and will be seeking augmentation. All of our small and rural monies that were available have been used, so they are eligible to use STBG funding (\$225,000). They would like to move forward in December. A lot of discussion on the topic and it will be discussed further at November meeting.
