1. What would you bring to the team if offered the Transportation Planner position?
2. What job skills do you feel you could use training on? Why?
3. The Transportation Planner will work with 14 member jurisdictions, multiple levels of government, and transportation agencies and stakeholders. How would you anticipate serving all 14 YVCOG member jurisdictions with competing priorities? How do you react when a project that you have spent time on is not well received or is rejected?
